

# Majors Diamond - Score Board Instructions

## Setup

- Get the score booth key from the cupboard under the score booth
- Open the yellow lock box with a B key
- Get out the scoreboard controller
- On the left hand wall there are two switches – one of the switches has an arrow pointing up and down. Press the top of this switch to raise the scoreboard cover. You do not have to hold the switch down
- Next to this switch this is a plug to be used to plug in the scoreboard controller
- Plug in and turn on the controller using the on/off switch on the back of the controller
- Press ENTER and the scoreboard should show lights



## Game Scoring

- Use the scoreboard controller to enter:
  - Balls (button: Ball +1)
  - Strikes (button: Strike +1)
  - Outs (button: Out +1)
  - Runs for home (button: Home Score +1)
  - Runs for guest (button: Guest Score +1)
  - Current inning (button: Inning +1)
- Use the pitch count controller to controller the pitch count for each team
  - Simply flick switch between home/away to count for each team
- At the end of each batter use the “Clear ball & strike” button
- There is no minus function for balls, strikes or outs (if you make a mistake use either the clear balls/strikes button or keep entering balls/strikes or outs until it resets to zero)
- When a new pitcher enters the game repeatedly tap the Pitch Count -1 button to reset to zero

## After the Game

- Unplug the scoreboard controller and return it to the yellow lock box
- Use the switch to close the cover on the scoreboard
- Lock the score booth and return the key to the cupboard under the score booth

## Score Booth Etiquette

- Home team “owns” the score booth
- Away team should score from the bleachers unless invited in by the home team
- Please do not cheer or comment on the game from the score booth
  - Sound carries directly to the plate area so please keep your voices low
