

Seycove Diamond - Score Board Instructions

The Home team is responsible for setup, operation and take-down of the scoreboard at each game. Please do not use the scoreboard if the game is likely to be played in significant rain.

Setup

- The scoreboard and tripod are stored in the Seycove equipment locker
- Open the locker with a “b” key

Tripod

- Take the tripod out from the equipment locker
- Set up the tripod in foul territory on the 3rd base line (halfway between 3rd base and pylons)
- Extend the legs and then step gently on the “feet” to dig the legs into the grass
- Open the clip on each leg and then raise the tripod to a good viewing height
- Close the clips to secure the legs at this height

Scoreboard

- Take the scoreboard out of the equipment locker
- Slide the scoreboard on to the pole at the top of the tripod
- Remove the scoreboard cover
- Press the green button on the top of the scoreboard to turn it on

Remote

- Remove the remote control from the back of the scoreboard
- Give the remote to the volunteer operating the scoreboard

Game Scoring

- Use the scoreboard remote to enter:
 - Balls (button: BALL)
 - Strikes (button: STRIKE)
 - Outs (button: OUT)
 - Runs for home (button: HOME)
 - Runs for guest (button: GUEST)
 - Current inning (button: INNING)
- To reset any item press button: CLR ITEM followed by the button for the item you wish to clear (i.e. CLR ITEM - BALL) will remove all balls from the scoreboard
- There is no minus function for balls, strikes or outs (if you make a mistake continue tapping balls/strikes/outs as this will reset when it reaches the maximum)



After the Game

- Press the button: PWR OFF on the remote to turn the scoreboard off
- Please ensure the remote is re-attached to the back of the scoreboard
- Place the scoreboard cover back on
- Remove the scoreboard from the tripod and place carefully back in the equipment locker
- Pack up the tripod and place it back in the equipment locker



1. Remove the tripod from the locker



2. Extend the tripod legs



3. Dig the feet into the grass to secure



4. Open the leg clips to adjust the height



5. Remove the scoreboard cover



6. Get the scoreboard remote control



7. Press the green button to turn on

9. After the game turn off the scoreboard with the PWR OFF button and place the remote back in place.



8. Use remote to control the scoreboard

10. Ensure that the scoreboard and tripod are packed away carefully in the storage locker.
